## How to Access Azure Cost Management (ACM)

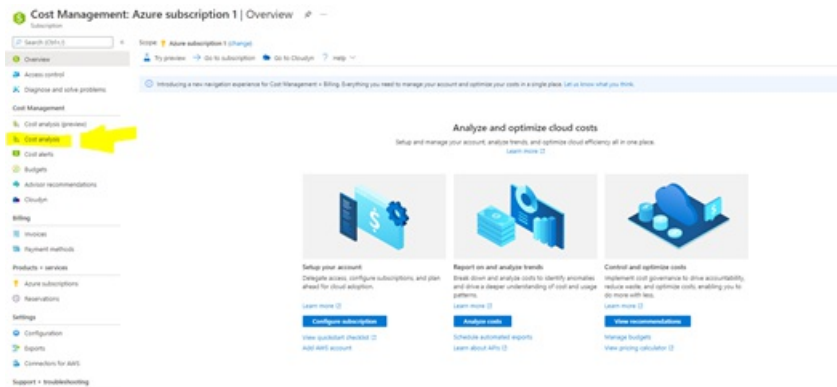
1. Log in to partner centre (<https://partner.microsoft.com/dashboard>)
2. Go via CSP > Customers, and search for your customer.
3. Find your customer and click the arrow to open the 'administer services' section.

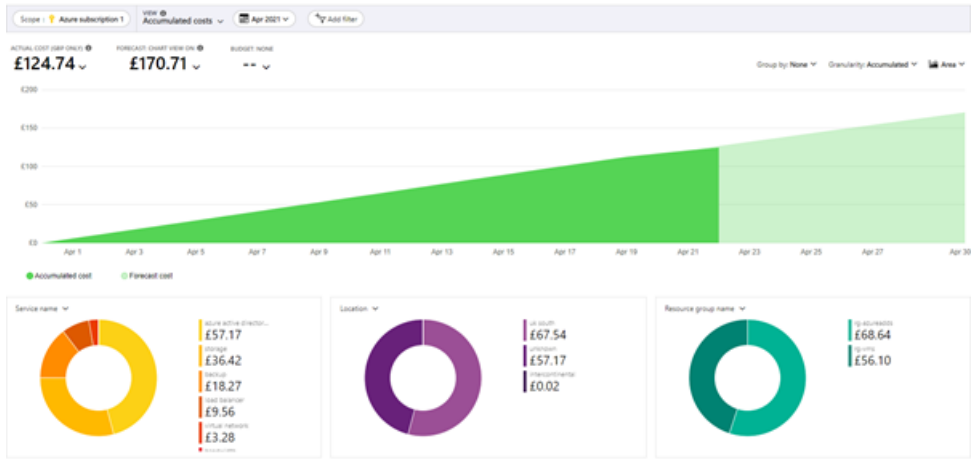
4. From here, select **Microsoft Azure Management Portal** to open their portal - please note that you will need to ensure that you have permissions over the subscription.
